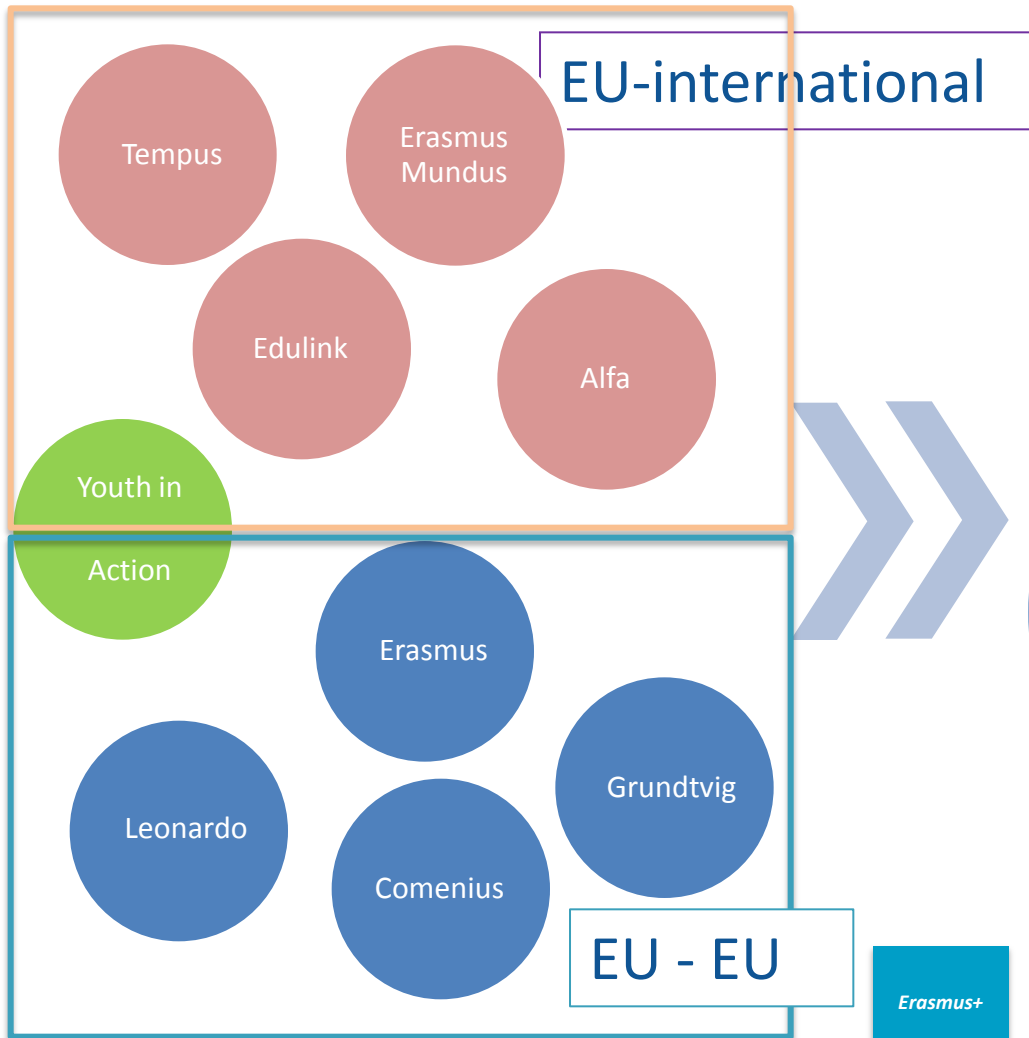

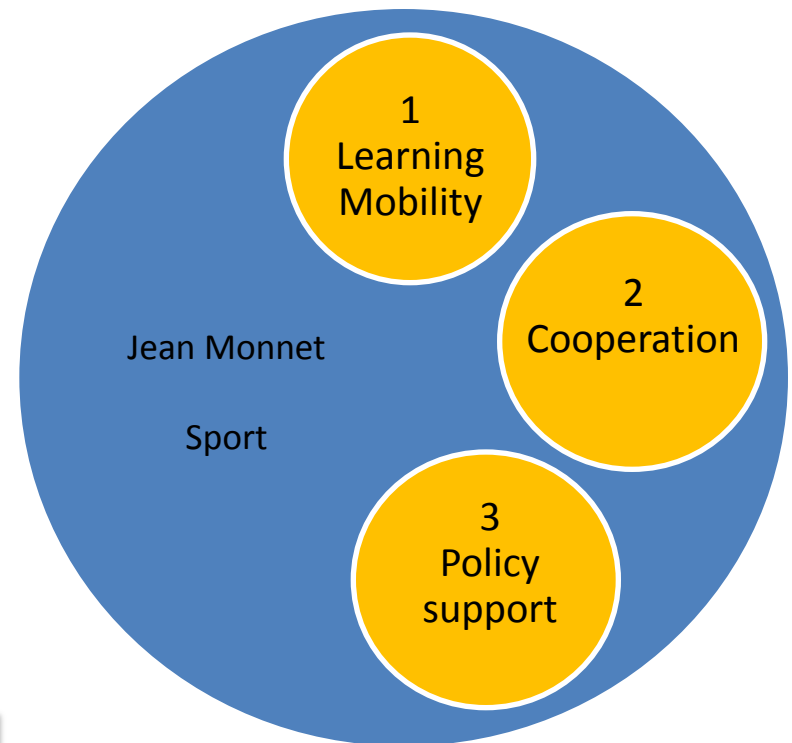

# CBHE objectives

Build the capacity and help modernise HEIs in Partner countries, to ensure structural, long-lasting impact

- Support **modernisation & internationalisation**
- Improve **quality**
- Improve the level of **skills & competences**
- Enhance **management, governance** in HEIs
- Promote people-to-people **contacts, intercultural understanding**
- Voluntary convergence w/ **EU HE policy developments**

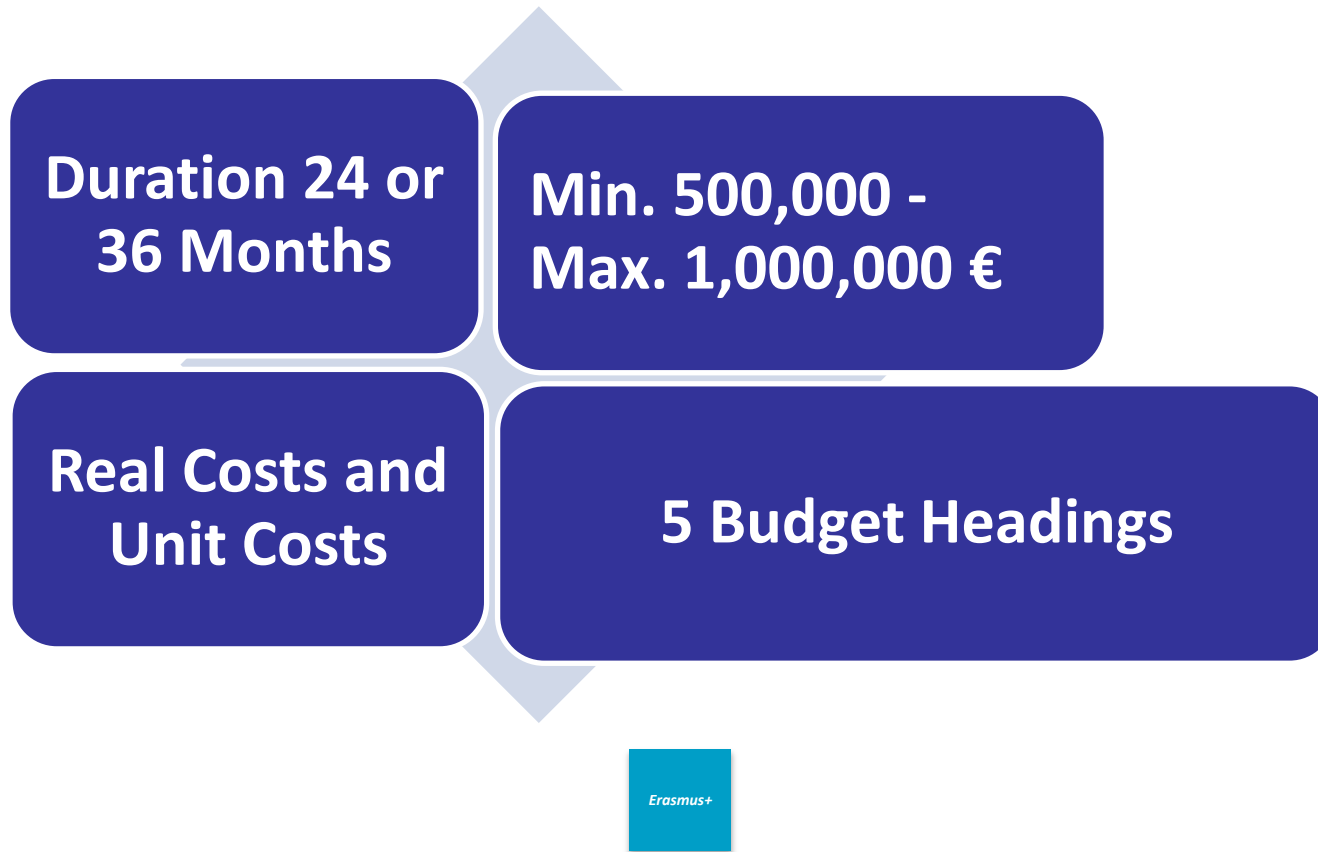
# CBHE: how does it work?

- Projects of 2 or 3 years
- Projects run by consortium of institutions
- Consortium must include both Programme & Partner countries (**min. 2 Program countries**)
- Project can be coordinated by a Programme or a Partner Country
- **Minimum number of HEIs from Montenegro – 1 HEIs is enough**



# Budget and Duration

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## How to calculate the budget:

### Categories

<b>Staff costs (max 40%)</b>	<b>4 Staff Categories</b> (Manager, Researcher/ Teacher/Trainer, Technician, Administrator)
<b>Travel costs</b>	<b>Students/staff from partners</b> in countries involved in the project from their place of origin to the venue of the activity and return.
<b>Costs of stay</b>	Subsistence, accommodation, local and public transport, personal or optional health insurance.
<b>Equipment (max 30%)</b>	Purchased <u>exclusively</u> for the benefit of HEIs in the Partner Countries
<b>Sub-contracting (max 10%)</b>	Exceptional for services related to competences that can't be found in the consortia

# CBHE: how to apply

- Annual Calls for Proposals
- Proposals assessed by experts for: relevance, quality of design, quality of team, impact & dissemination
- Applications may be from a Partner or Programme country HEIs
- Deadline for application: **8 February, 2018**
- Project start: **15 November 2018 or 15 January 2019**
- Apply direct to EACEA

# Novelties for 2018 Call for CBHE

- The Special Mobility Strand removed
- Subject and thematic priority areas simplified: now 3 priority areas instead of 4, according to the types of projects
- Minimum number of Programme Countries in an eligible CBHE consortium reduced from 3 to 2 countries
- 2 options for the start of the eligibility period in the future CBHE projects : 15 November 2018 or 15 January 2019
- **The grant for the highest travel band has been increased to 1.500 Euros**
- *Budget calculation: Exceptional costs (E+ Programme level)*

# Priorities & Types of projects

National Priorities defined by the **Ministries of Education** in close consultation with the EU Delegations

Regional priorities defined by the **Commission** and based on EU's external policy priorities

## National Projects

National projects must address:

**National Priorities** set for Partner Country in Regions 1, 2, 3, 7, 10

**Regional Priorities** for the regions where no national priorities are established:  
Regions 4, 6, 8, 9, 11

## Multi-Country Projects

**Regional** priorities apply to multi-country projects in the same region

Combination of **regional + national** priorities common to all partner countries may also be accepted  
(in particular for cross-regional projects)

# National priorities for Joint and Structural Projects

<b>2</b>	<b><i>Governance, strategic planning and management of HEIs</i></b> (such as human resources and financial management); <b><i>University services</i></b> (such as support services for student mobility, student counselling and guidance, social services, academic affairs, libraries, etc.); <b><i>Internationalization of HEIs</i></b> (including recognition mechanism and mobility, international relations capacities); <b><i>Quality assurance processes and mechanisms</i></b> (such as the development of mechanism and benchmarks for quality assurance in different segments of HE-academic contents and services)
<b>3</b>	<b><i>Development of school and vocational education at post-secondary non-tertiary education level</i></b> (such as reforming in-service training for teachers and reforms to the teaching profession); <b><i>University-enterprise cooperation</i></b> (such as support for student's practical placement, entrepreneurship, employability of graduates, etc.); <b><i>Definition, implementation and monitoring of reform policies</i></b> (including evidence-based policies, financing of education, governance, quality assurance of public and private higher education sector, introduction of transparency tools and standards and guidelines)

<b>1</b>	<b><i>Education; Physical sciences; Engineering and engineering trades; Agriculture, forestry, fisheries and veterinary; Health; Transport services; Environment</i></b>
<b>2</b>	<b><i>Governance, strategic planing and management of HEIs</i></b> (such as human resources and financial management); <b><i>Internationalization of HEIs</i></b> (including recognition mechanism and mobility, international relations capacities); <b><i>Equity, access to and democratiposition of higher education</i></b> (including disadvantaged groups of people and regions)
<b>3</b>	<b><i>Non-University sector at tertiary education level</i></b> (actions which target reforms in vocational and technical vocational education and training institutes and colleges which are offering tertiary education but are not universities); <b><i>University-enterprise cooperation</i></b> (such as support for student's practical placement, entrepreneurship, employability of graduates, etc.); <b><i>Recognition of qualifications and Qualification frameworks</i></b> <b><i>Definition, implementation and monitoring of reform policies</i></b> (including evidence-based policies, inancing of education, governance, quality assurance of public and private higher education sector, introduction of transparency tools and standards and guidelines)



# Key messages for 2018

- Pay attention to the eligibility criteria (mainly minimum number of nationally recognised HEIs in consortia)
- High cross-cutting priority - proposals addressing Refugees
- Encourage the diversification of projects in terms of overall and specific objectives, activities, target groups and consortium composition
- Check carefully the revised national and regional priorities (in case of resubmission)
- Consider properly the relevance of cross-regional application

Deadline for submission of applications	<b>8 February 2018</b>
Verification of eligibility of applications	February – March 2018
Assessment of projects by experts & consultation of EU Delegations	March – June 2018
Final Evaluation Committee meeting for selection of projects	Mid-July 2018
Award decision	End-July 2018
Notification of results; Publication of selection results on the EACEA website	August 2018
Start of eligibility period	<b>15 November 2018</b> <b>15 January 2019</b>
