















DAAD funding recipients (2012)






Origins and destinations of DAAD scholarship holders *




DAAD funding recipients (2012) – Subjects *

* not including EU programmes








Projects by German higher education institutions with **DAAD** funding

DAAD scholarships

Study trips for groups (headed by a university teacher)

Who? Students (10-15 persons, who finished the 2nd semester) How long? 7-12 days

The DAAD usually arranges the program. Wishes and preferences stated in the application form will be considered. Application deadlines: 01.02.; 01.05.; 01.11.

Scholarship:

DAAD - provides a guide in the group language

- pays for accommodation expenses (including breakfast)
- 9 Euro per person/per day for lunch and dinner



Research Grants for Young Scientists and Academics

How long? 1-10 months, up to 4 years for doctoral candidates **Who?** Doctoral candidates, young scientists and academics

Requirements:

- Master or Diploma degree
- Excellent research proposal
- Invitation by German University teacher
- Good knowledge of German or English

Scholarship:

monthly award of 750,- up to 1000,- euros (depending on the degree) plus travel costs



Research Stay for Academics and Scientists

How long? 1-3 months

Who? Scientists and Academics

Requirements

- Excellent research proposal
- recent publications
- Invitation by a German Colleague
- Good knowledge of German or English
- Working in higher education or at research institutes

Scholarship:

monthly award between 2.000 and 2.300 euros plus travel costs
