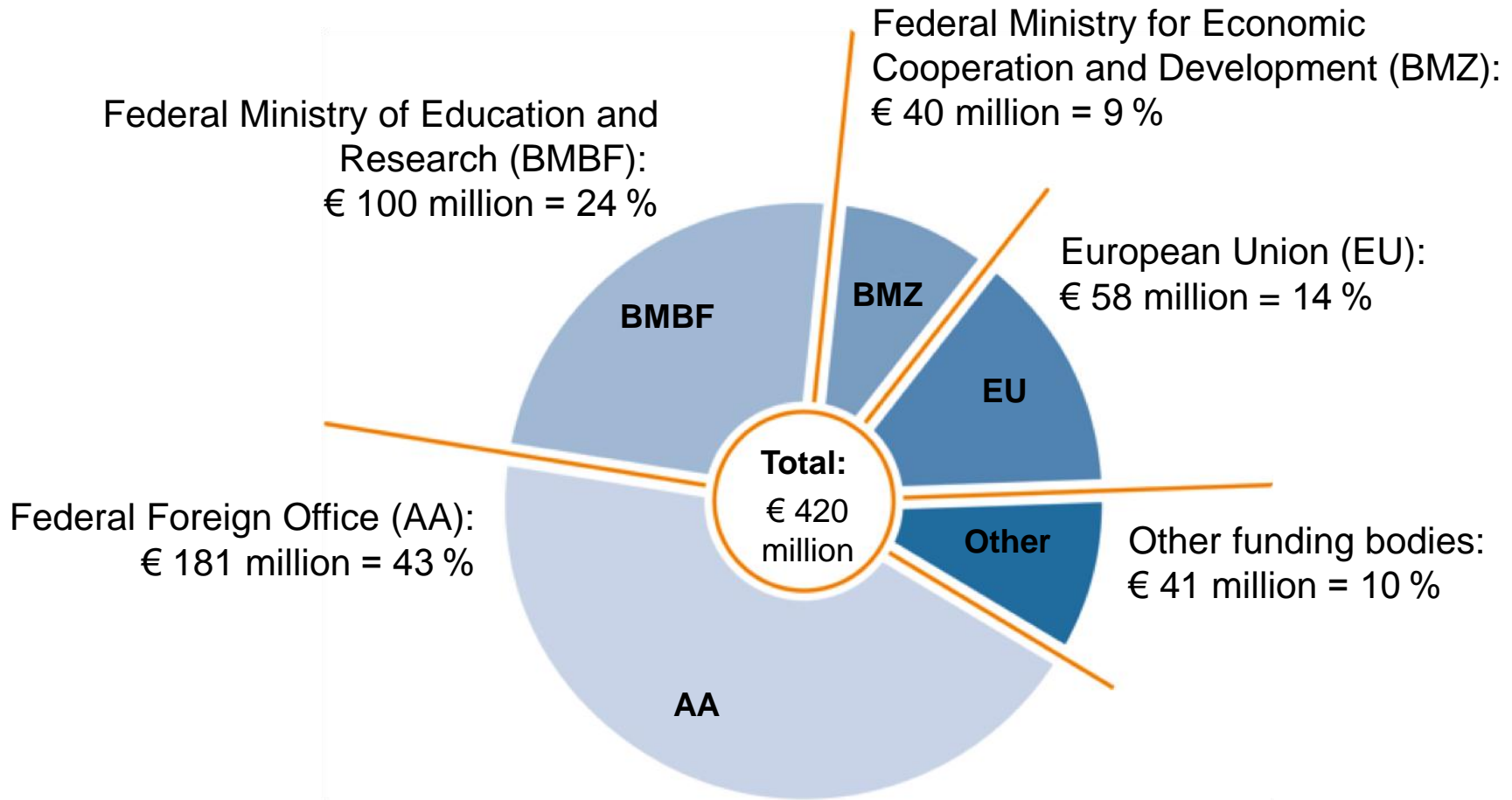
# The German Academic Exchange Service (DAAD) is ...

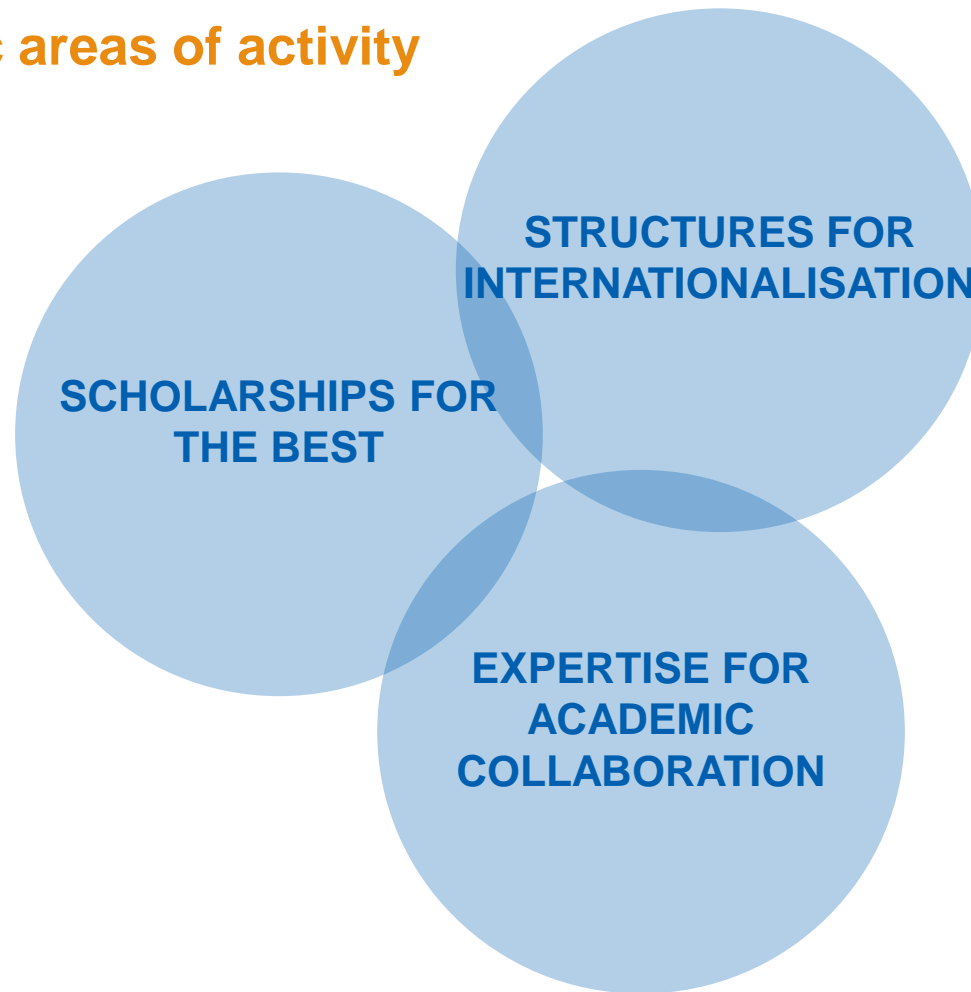


## The DAAD supports academic exchange in three main areas:

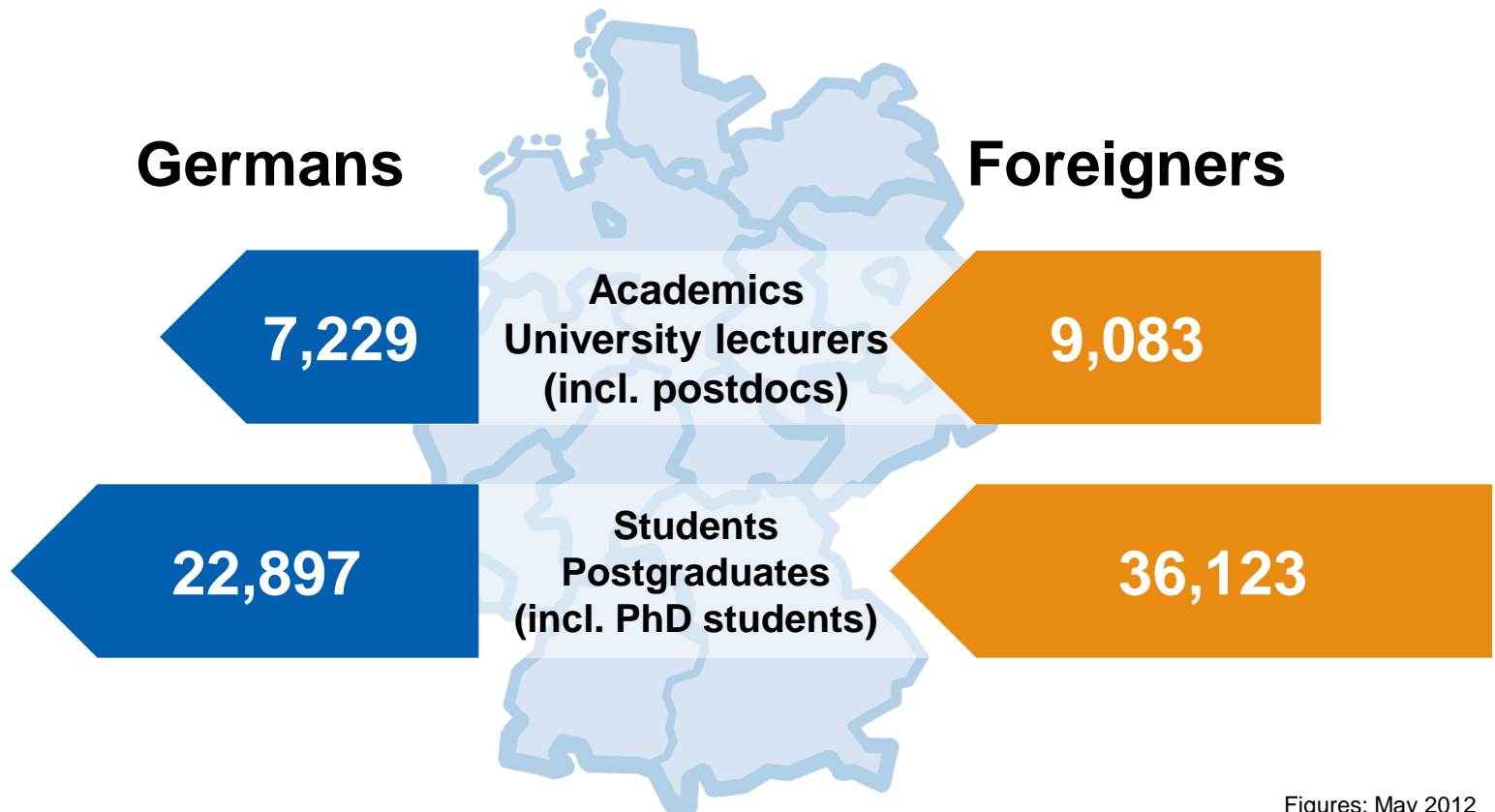

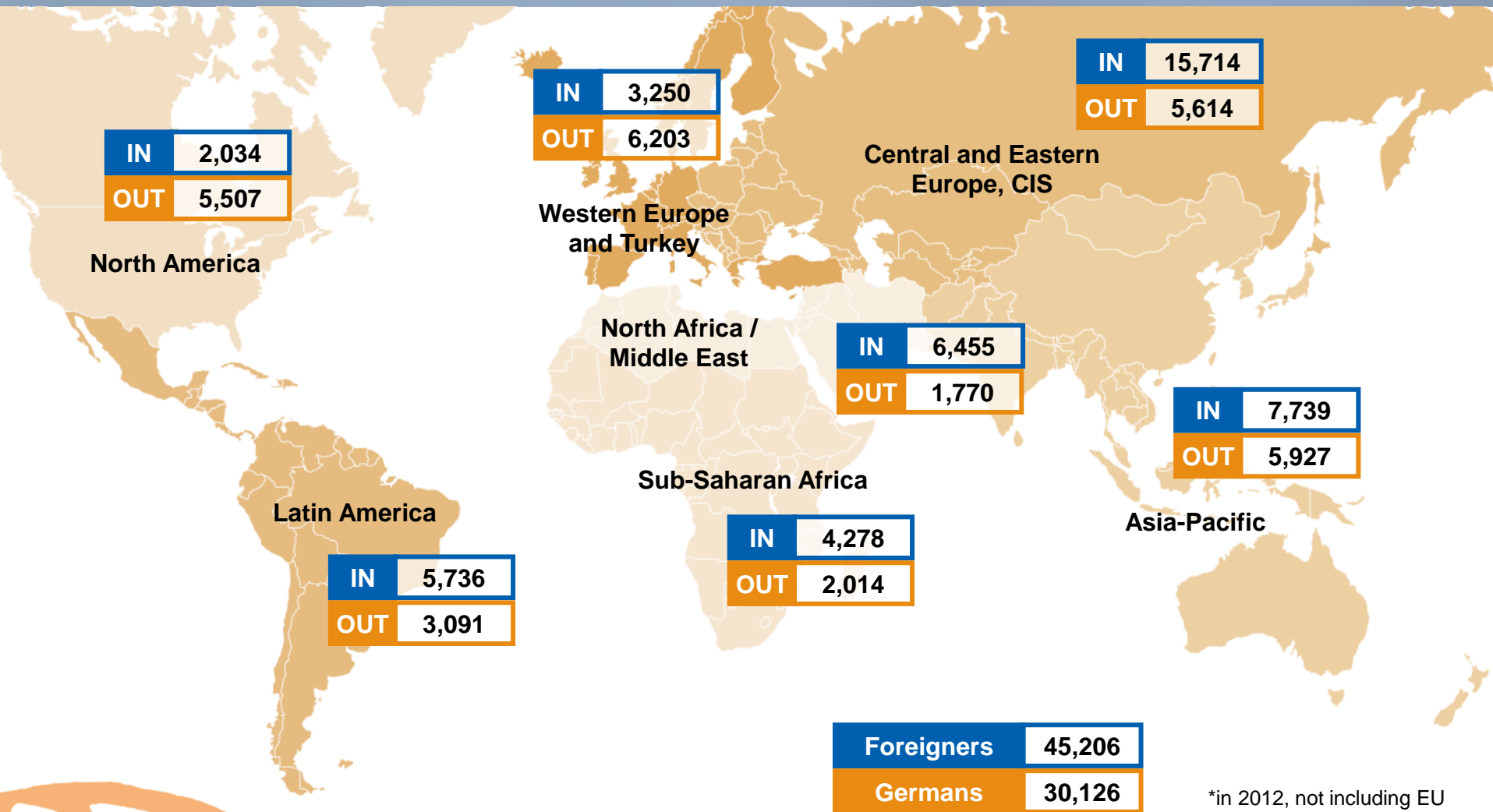

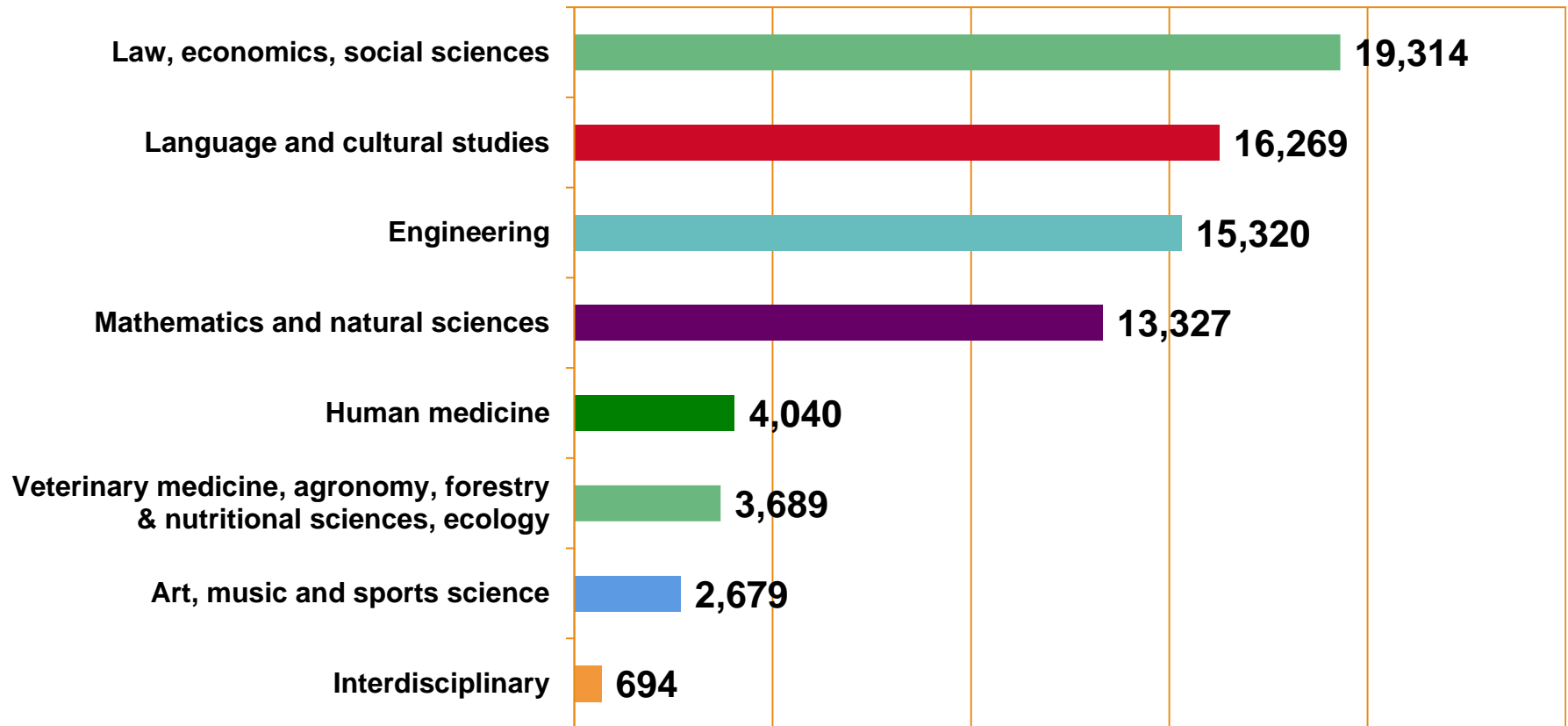
# Origins and destinations of DAAD scholarship holders \*

\* not including EU programmes



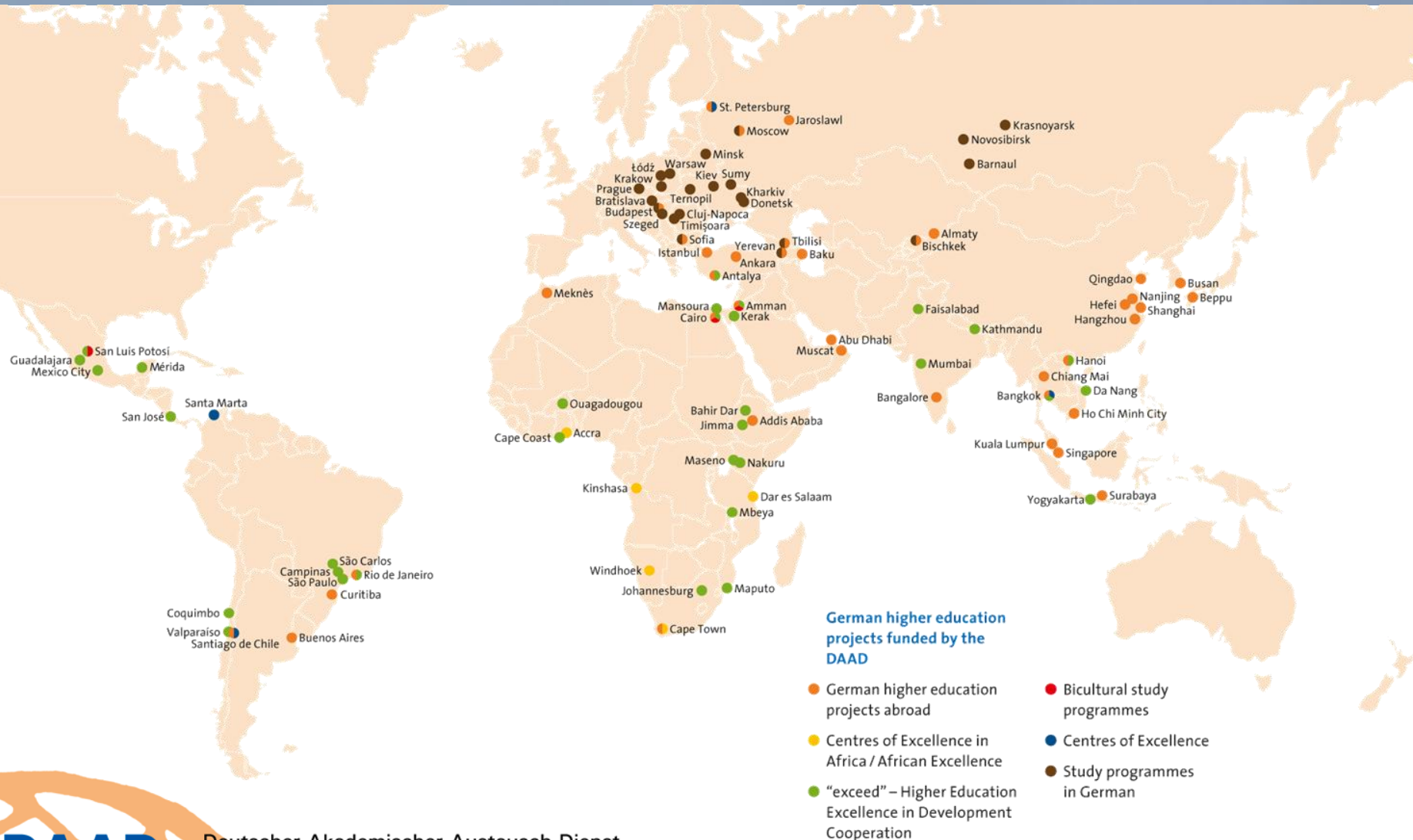


## Structures for Internationalisation:

# Projects by German higher education institutions with DAAD funding

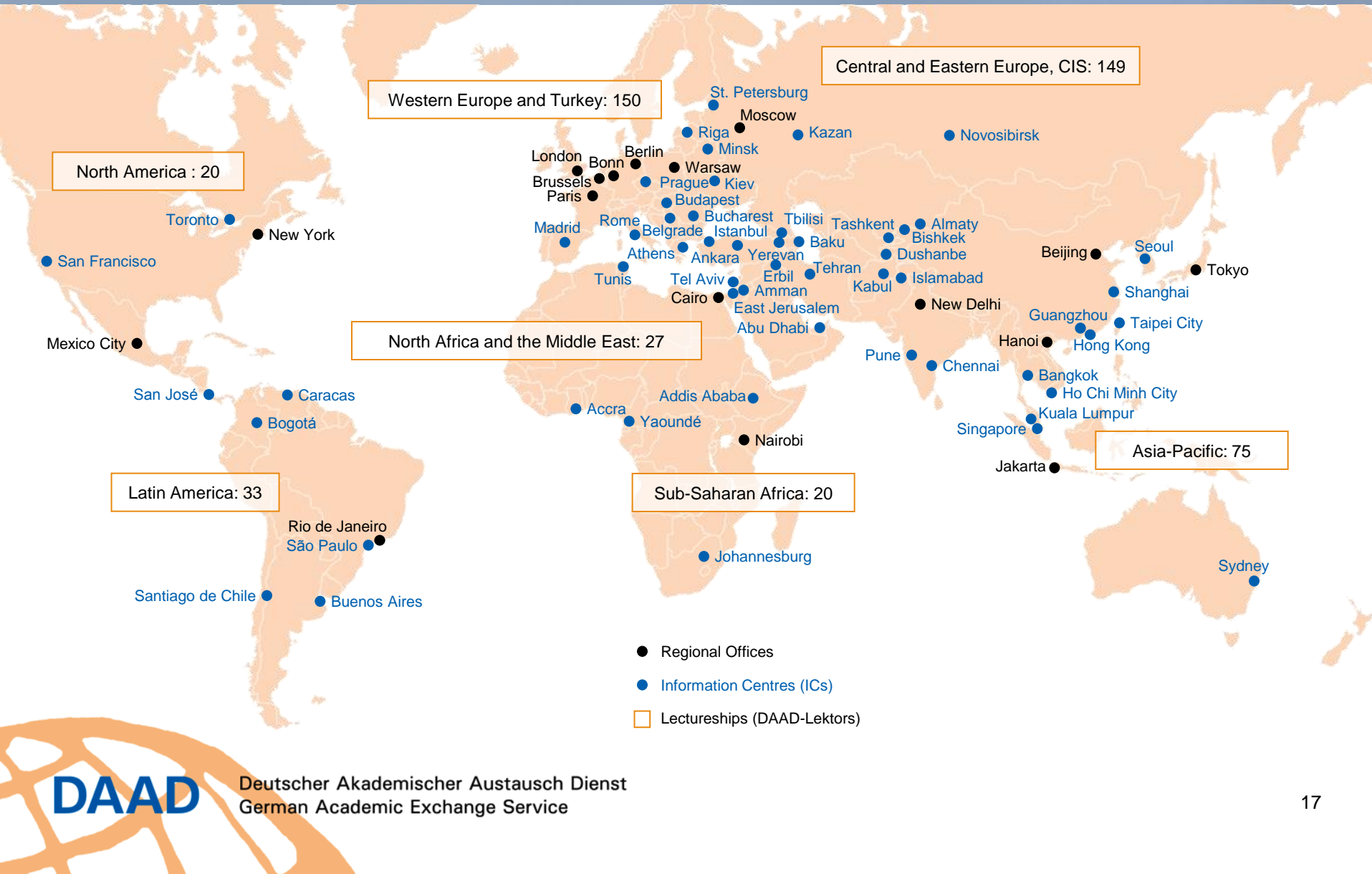




## Expertise for academic collaboration:

# DAAD scholarships

# Study trips for groups (headed by a university teacher)

**Who?** Students (10-15 persons, who finished the 2<sup>nd</sup> semester)

**How long?** 7-12 days

The DAAD usually arranges the program. Wishes and preferences stated in the application form will be considered.

Application deadlines: 01.02.; 01.05.; 01.11.

## **Scholarship:**

DAAD - provides a guide in the group language

- pays for accommodation expenses (including breakfast)
- 9 Euro per person/per day for lunch and dinner

# Research Grants for Young Scientists and Academics

**How long?** 1-10 months, up to 4 years for doctoral candidates

**Who?** Doctoral candidates, young scientists and academics

## **Requirements:**

- Master or Diploma degree
- Excellent research proposal
- Invitation by German University teacher
- Good knowledge of German or English

## **Scholarship:**

monthly award of 750,- up to 1000,- euros  
(depending on the degree) plus travel costs



# Research Stay for Academics and Scientists

**How long?** 1-3 months

**Who?** Scientists and Academics

## Requirements

- Excellent research proposal
- recent publications
- Invitation by a German Colleague
- Good knowledge of German or English
- Working in higher education or at research institutes

## Scholarship:

monthly award between 2.000 and 2.300 euros plus travel costs
