

• Capacity development




- Reciprocity and mutual benefit

- The department is the initiator and project owner but...
- ... Linnaeus-Palme must be a part of the university's international profile

Long term perspective important – a project can be granted during eight years





Linnaeus-Palme do not...

... offer a total funding!

A certain self-financing is required by involved department or university.

Recommend to solve the housing on early stage.



Linnaeus-Palme student exchange

No tution fees within Linnaeus-Palme

(Swedish): 25 000 SEK for 20 weeks (3 800 USD) 40 000 SEK for 40 weeks (6 100 USD)

(non-Swedish): 53 000 SEK for 20 weeks (8 090 USD) 89 000 SEK for 40 weeks (13 600 USD)



Academic year 2013/14

279 applications of which 214 were granted33 Swedish universities awarded a total of almost SEK41.8 million
